Groupe Delcourt, which is comprised of Éditions Delcourt and Soleil, is the first independent publishing group of French-speaking comics. Between 2018 and 2020, Groupe Delcourt opened up to literature by launching La Croisée (foreign literature) and Les Avrils (French literature), and acquiring Éditions Marchialy (narrative non-fiction). In 2021, the Groupe unveiled Verytoon, a platform for Korean webtoons, and was the first publisher to put them to paper with the Kbooks line. 2023 marked the creation of a collection of illustrated books for children: “Sens Dessus Dessous” [Sensiful Upside Down].
