Founded in 1900, Éditions Albin Michel is one of the rare French publishing houses that is still independent, and one of the top ten players in the French publishing market. Today, the catalogue boasts 6,000 titles with 500 new titles added yearly. In 2020, Albin Michel diversified its activities by launching a comics division. In its first year, two major hits were published: *Sapiens*, a graphic adaptation of the best-selling essay by Yuval Noah Harari, with rights already sold in 36 languages, and the punk graphic novel *Vernon Subutex* by Virginie Despentes and Luz, which has sold 110,000 copies so far.
